### Vision Alma Funding Announcement

May 24, 2016



I was pleased to announce \$845,631 in Federal Funding for the Vision Alma project on behalf of the Honourable Navdeep Bains, Minister of Innovation, Science and Economic Development and Minister responsible for the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA) on May 24.

The total investment announced from the Federal, Provincial and Municipal governments is more than \$950,000 to help this project become a reality.

Vision Alma is a strategic community project to create a tourism commons hub in the centre of the village that will complement current tourism offerings in this community, while increasing economic opportunities all along the Fundy coast. This investment will help strengthen the local tourism infrastructure which ultimately will attract more visitors, promote longer stays, and increase tourist generated revenue in the region.



I had the pleasure of announcing \$25,000 in funding for the Curryville Community Outreach Centre on behalf of the Honourable Jean-Yves Duclos, Minister of Families, Children and Social Development through the New Horizons for Seniors Program (NHSP) on April 25.

The project will see renovations completed to the centre's community kitchen including flooring, heaters and new appliances to continue activities and offer new activities such as preparing pickles/jams to support seniors' participation.

Community-based project funding supports activities that engage seniors and address one or more of the program's five objectives: volunteering, mentoring, expanding awareness of elder abuse, social participation and capital assistance.
